In this proceeding complainant seeks an order of the Commission directing defendants to waive undercharges outstanding against eight carload shipments of olives transported from Reedley, Visalia and Cairns to Sylmar. These same shipments are involved in Case 2558, Sylmar Packing Corporation vs. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway et al., and are covered by our order in Decision No. 25672 of this date. This proceeding should therefore be dismissed.
