

Decision No. 25882

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of F.R. DUNN and ALEXANDER LOGIE, and PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California authorizing applicants to enter into a written agreement in words and figures as written in the form therefor which is hereunto annexed.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and F.R. Dunn and Alexander Logie, who are engaged in mining operations in Butte County, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement substantially in accordance with the words and figures as written in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above mentioned parties, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said F.R. Dunn and Alexander Logie, on an accommodation basis when same is available and shall be required for mining purposes, of surplus water in the company's Miocene Canal at the northwest quarter (N.W.¼) of the southeast quarter (S.E.¼) of Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, in Butte County, California, same not to exceed twenty (20) miner's inches, at a rate of twelve and one-half cents (12½¢) per miner's inch day, and it appearing that this is not a matter

in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and F.R. Dunn and Alexander Logie be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of surplus water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
