FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Further Order appearing
on Page 4 of Decision No. 24584 of the above numbered application
be amended to read as follows:

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the request of
applicant to terminate the present Lake Avenue-Mendocino
Street rail service at Woodbury Road and Lake Avenue
and discontinue local rail service and abandon all rail
facilities between the intersection of Mendocino Street
and Allen Avenue and the intersection of Woodbury Road
and Lake Avenue is herein granted, subject to the
condition that service over said line shall not be dis-
continued until the Mendocino-New York Avenue motor coach
line (Line No. 8), certificate for which is herein author-
ized, has been placed in operation.

In all other respects Decision No. 24584 shall remain
in full force and effect.
