## OPINION and ORDER

Ehmer F. Smith, operating a service by truck for the transportation of property between Burbank and San Diego, El Centro, Bakersfield and Santa Barbara and intermediate points, has made application to discontinue service and to revoke the rights heretofore granted by Decision No. 15946, dated February 6, 1926, on Application No. 11911.

Applicant performs service only for the Empire China Company and J.R. Wartman Plaster Company of Burbank. He alleges that the companies are out of business and that he has not operated any service since February 20, 1932.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary.

The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Elmer F. Smith operating automotive service for the transportation of property between Burbank and various points and over various routes in southern California, and as authorized by Decision No. 15946, dated February 6, 1926, on Application No. 11911 be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all such service, provided, however, that

applicant shall immediately file with this Commission cancellation of tariffs and time schedules now on file therefor, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 15946, dated February 6, 1926, on Application No. 11911 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
