No. 16228. 22558, 25078 and 25370. BY THE COMMISSION: OPINION Pacific Motor Transport Company, a corporation, operating an automotive service for the transportation of property between San Jose and Santa Cruz, via Los Gatos and Watsonville, has applied for authority to reduce its service between Los Gatos and Santa Cruz to an "on call" operation only. Applicant now has on file a time schedule requiring daily service (except Sunday) between Los Gatos and Santa Cruz. By Decision No. 25370, dated Movember 21, 1932, applicant was authorized to operate a daily service between Watsonville Junction and Santa Cruz, which serves as an alternative route for traffic handled via the San Jose-Santa Cruz route. Since the inauguration of service via Watsonville Junction the daily service between los Gatos and Senta Cruz has not been used to any extent by the public. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessery. The application will be granted. ORDER The above entitled application of Pacific Motor Transport Company having been duly considered and the Commission being advised in the premises, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant be and it is hereby authorized to withdraw its time schedules between Los Gatos and

Santa Cruz and to file in lieu thereof schedules for "on demand", provided applicant shall post notice at the terminals of los Gatos, Watsonville and Santa Cruz, at least five (5) days before the effective date of such withdrawal of deily schedules.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decisions Nos. 22558, 25078 and 25370 on Application No. 16228 shall remain unaltered.
