OPINION AND ORDER

Fred A. Minaker, operating an auto stage line for the transportation of persons between Porterville and California Hot Springs via Ducor by authority of Decision No. 7847, dated July 9, 1920, on Application No. 4518, has made application to abandon the route via Ducor and the points of Fountain Springs, Zaluds, Rogers and Slinkards and to reroute the service between termini via Foothill Road. The route sought to be abandoned is restricted against any service between Ducor and Porterville. The points sought to be abandoned are mere names for points where formerly horsedrawn vehicles changed teams. The route to be abandoned is 39 miles long, while that via Foothill Road is but 29 miles in length.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not deemed necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 7847 herein be

amended by permitting applicant to abandon the route via Ducor and the points of Fountain Springs, Zaluds, Rogers and Slinkards and to reroute the service between termini via Foothill Road without intermediates, provided however applicant shall file within fifteen (15) days from date hereof, time schedules in duplicate covering the rerouting, and tariffs in triplicate covering the new service as herein provided.
