BY THE COMMISSION:

TWELFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9125 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein upon approval of the Railroad Commission based upon a change in the price paid for oil in the various communities served, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that a decrease in the price of oil was made effective March 5, 1933,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease its rates for artificial gas service, as determined in Decision No. 22373, effective for all meter readings taken on and after April 4, 1933, so that the rates of the several schedules shall be less than the basic rates of the respective schedules set forth in Decision No. 9125 by the following amounts:

Schedule G-7 . . . . 25¢ per 1,000 cubic feet  
Schedule G-8 . . . . 28¢ per 1,000 cubic feet

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for artificial gas service

rendered under Schedule No. G-7-H, effective for meter readings taken on and after April 4, 1933, so that the rates therein shall be one (1) cent per 1,000 cubic feet less than the rates now applying under that schedule.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for artificial gas service rendered under Schedule No. G-9, effective for meter readings taken on and after April 4, 1933, so that the rates therein shall be twenty-eight (28) cents per 1,000 cubic feet less than the rates set forth in Decision No. 9125 for Schedule G-8, of which the present Schedule G-9 is but a variation necessary to meet local conditions.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with this Commission on or before April 30, 1933, revisions of its schedules as herein authorized.
