ORIGINAL

Applicant herein now operates truck transportation service for the transportation of shipments consigned to Railway Express Agency, Incorporated of Delaware, between Rio Vista and Sacramento and intermediate points, and also between such points and Elk Grove, Galt, Lodi and Stockton for delivery only to railway trains.

In its second supplemental application applicant seeks a return movement of such property consigned to the Express Company from Lodi and Thornton to points upon its service between Rio Vista and Sacramento. The additional rights sought will be no more than pick-up of consignments to Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, at Lodi and Thornton and transporting them to its Delta line service between Rio Vista and Sacramento. The authority sought is to meet emergencies in rapid transportation, particularly in connection with shipments of American Fruit Growers at Lodi because of the discontinuance of Southern Pacific train No. 232, eliminating late pick-up by rail at the points affected, - also discontinuance of Western Pacific service creating the same condition at Thornton. No alteration of rates or schedules will be caused

by the grant and the service is to be only in emergencies,  
on demand.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not deemed  
necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED O R D E R that Decision No.25455, dated  
December 19, 1932, on the instant application, be and it is  
hereby amended to include movements of property consigned to  
Railway Express Agency, Inc. of Delaware between Lodi and  
Thornton and points served by applicant under Decision No.24134,  
in either direction, on demand, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, except as herein amended,  
said Decisions Nos.24134 and 25455 shall remain unchanged.
