O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 25745 on the instant application, Pacific Motor Transport Company was authorized to transport property for Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency, Inc. of Delaware between Surf, Lompoc and White Hills. In this supplemental application applicant seeks authority to carry property of the Pacific Motor Transport Company between the same points and over the same route, in addition to the property transported for the Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order heretofore made in Decision No. 25745, dated March 20, 1933 herein, condition No. 1 be amended as follows:

(1) The certificate herein granted is limited to the transportation of property consigned to Southern Pacific Company, Railway Express Agency, Inc. or Pacific Motor Transport Company regardless of origin or destination.

In all other respects Decision No. 25745 shall remain unchanged.
