O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company on March 22, 1933, applied for authority to cancel all freight tariffs and to discontinue the handling of freight to and from the non-agency station of Perry, located on the main line of its Coast Division in Santa Clara County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that there was no carload or less-than-carload freight business transacted at said station during the years 1931 and 1932 and that in applicant's opinion the continued maintenance of this non-agency freight station is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation signified in writing that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It is shown in the application that the nearest agency to the south of Perry is Morgan Hill, located a distance of 4.5 miles, and Coyote, 3.2 miles to the north.

It appears that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency freight station of Perry, located on Southern Pacific Company's main line of its Coast Division in Santa Clara County, California, and to change its respective records and tariffs accordingly, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall notify the public of the abandonment of the said non-agency freight station by posting notice in advance for at least ten (10) days in a conspicuous place at said non-agency station of Perry.
2. Applicant shall continue the usual passenger service at said station.
3. Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
4. The authority herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
