H. Bay Webster and M. L. Webster, doing business under the firm name and style of Webster Transportation Company, may transfer to Citizens Transit Company, a corporation, the operative rights and properties referred to in the opinion of said Decision No. 25792, dated April 3, 1933, and also the operative right acquired under the authority granted by Decision No. 21780, dated November 12, 1929, in Application No. 16044, subject to outstanding liabilities of approximately \$1,300,000 and imately \$1,300.00; and Citizens Transit Company may acquire the operative rights and properties authorized to be transferred by this First Supplemental Order, and in payment

therefor may issue \$7,997.00 par value of its common capital stock and assume the payment of approximately \$1,300.00 of liabilities."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in said Decision No. 25792, dated April 3, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect, effect as Modified by this First Supplemental order.
