FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 25677 of February 27, 1933, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended as follows:

Change the destination point shown in the sixth and seventh lines of the tabulation appearing on page 2 of the type-written decision now reading "Los Angeles" to read "Los Angeles Harbor".

Eliminate the last sentence appearing on the same page reading "Defendants should establish for the future rates not in excess of those herein found reasonable".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 25677 of February 27, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect.
