SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having applied to the Rail-
road Commission for permission to use the proceeds obtained from the sale
of \$1,000,000 of the stock which the Railroad Commission has heretofore
authorized to be issued, to reimburse itself for moneys expended in pay-
ing the \$1,000,000 of 7 percent. debentures that matured on January 15,
1922, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that applicant's
request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company
be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the proceeds obtained from the
sale of \$1,000,000 of the stock authorized to be issued and sold by or-
ders in decisions in Applications Numbers 2743, 4790, 5312, 6426 and
7373 to reimburse itself for moneys expended in paying the \$1,000,000
of 7 percent. debentures that matured on January 15, 1922;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the orders in decisions in
Applications Numbers 2743, 4790, 5312, 6426 and 7373 shall remain in
full force and effect, except as modified by this Second Supplemental
Order.
