BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

Oakland and Antioch Land Company having made application to this Commission for authority to transfer its distribution pipe system, service pipes and meters, adjacent to the Town of Concord, Contra Costa County, to Port Costa Water Company, and Port Costa Water Company having joined in the application,

And it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Oakland and Antioch Land Company be and the same is hereby authorized to transfer to Port Costa Water Company its distribution pipe system, service pipes and meters, consisting of 1605 feet of two-inch galvanized pipe, 850 feet of one and one half inch pipe, 400 feet of three quarter inch pipe, thirteen services and the necessary meters, located upon a tract of land adjacent to the Town of Concord and

shown upon "R. N. Burgess Company's Map No. 3, a Portion of Parkside Addition and Racetrack Subdivision, Contra Costa County, California, being a portion of Rancho Monte del Diablo", subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before February 28, 1922, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Oakland and Antioch Land Company within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which the Oakland and Antioch Land Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
