BY THE COMMISSION,

O R D E R

In this proceeding H. E. Wilkinson has made application to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing him to sell and Henry Denning for an order authorizing him to purchase the operative right authorizing the operation of an automobile truck line between Seugus and Los Angeles together with the equipment used in such business.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by H. E. Wilkinson under Decision No. 9278 in Application No. 6831, dated July 27, 1921 and authorizes the operation by H. E. Wilkinson of an automobile truck service as a common carrier of milk, eggs, dairy and poultry supplies only between a territory comprising Seugus, Newhall and dairy and poultry ranches in the vicinity thereof on the one hand, and one-half mile or more northwesterly from San Fernando. It does not permit the carriage of the above named commodities from San Fernando or points between such towns to Los Angeles.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$600.00 which in-

cludes one Chevrolet truck and the operative right above mentioned. With the understanding that the proposed purchaser applicant Denning will conduct this operation strictly in accord with the limitations laid down in the decision granting the certificate to H. E. Wilkinson, this application will be granted.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.


2. That applicant H. E. Wilkinson shall immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3. That applicant Henry Denning shall immediately file tariff of rates and time schedules, in duplicate, in his own name, or adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant H. E. Wilkinson, all rates and time schedules to be identical with those filed by applicant Wilkinson.

4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. That no vehicle may be operated by applicant Henry Denning unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
