O R D E R

In this proceeding Curphey Truck Line, a corporation, has filed a joint application with M. R. Downing, as Administrator of the Estate of C. W. Curphey, deceased, in which it petitions the Railroad Commission for permission to transfer the operative rights heretofore granted to C. W. Curphey under Decision No. 7600.

By Decision No. 9582 in Application No. 7226, dated October 3, 1921, this Commission authorized M. R. Downing as Administrator of the Estate of C. W. Curphey, deceased, to transfer to the Curphey Truck Line, a corporation, the operative rights heretofore granted to C. W. Curphey, deceased, under Decision No. 7600.

Under the agreement entered into between the parties applicant therein, it was proposed to transfer such operative rights for a consideration of \$23,000.00, a portion of which was to be paid down and the balance in monthly installments. Due to the fact that the purchaser has been unable to meet payments called for under such agreement, applicants now request permission to transfer such operative rights back to the Estate of C. W. Curphey, deceased, and

It appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

That Curphey Truck Line, a corporation, shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules at present on file with the Railroad Commission of California, and applicant M. R. Downing, as Administrator of the Estate of C. W. Curphey, Deceased, shall immediately file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules, or shall adopt the tariff of rates and time schedules at present filed by the Curphey Truck Line, a corporation, all tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those at present on file with the Railroad Commission.
