FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having authorized SAN FERNANDO TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY by Decision No. 9197, dated June 30, 1921, to issue and sell at not less than par \$10,000.00 of common stock subject, among others, to the condition that none of the proceeds be expended except for such purposes as the Commission may hereafter authorize, and San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company having filed with the Commission a statement showing that it has expended for additions and betterments the sum of \$1,337.91, and that in addition to such expenditures, it has purchased telephone poles at a cost of \$517.70, making a total of \$1,855.61, and applicant having requested permission to pay for the additions and betterments and the telephone poles by withdrawing proceeds obtained from the sale of stock;

AND the Commission being of the opinion that SAN FERNANDO TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY should be granted permission to withdraw proceeds for the purposes mentioned;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 9197, dated June 30, 1921, be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit SAN FERNANDO TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to use \$1,855.61 to pay for the additions and betterments and for the telephone poles reported

in a statement filed with the Commission in the above entitled matter on February 9, 1922.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 9197, dated June 30, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
