ORDER

In this proceeding John Chicca has filed a joint application with Felice Gaspari in which applicant Chicca petitions the Commission for an order authorizing him to sell and applicant Gaspari for an order authorizing him to purchase and operate an automobile stage line engaged in the business as a common carrier of passengers and baggage between Bakersfield and Lost Hills.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by one F. C. Jewett under Decision No. 7750 in Application No. 5486, dated June 19, 1920, which certificate authorizes operation as hereinabove specified. Under Decision No. 9572 in Application No. 7192, F. C. Jewett was authorized to transfer this automobile stage line to John Chicca, one of the applicants herein.

Applicants give as the consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred, the sum of \$2,000, this property to include one Studebaker automobile at present used in the transportation of passengers between the points served, together with the equipment owned by applicant Chicca and the operative right authorizing such service.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. That applicant John Chicca shall immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
3. That applicant Felice Gaspari shall immediately file tariff of rates and time schedule, in duplicate, in his own name, or adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant John Chicca, all rates and time schedules to be identical with those filed by applicant Chicca.
4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.
5. That no vehicle may be operated by applicant Gaspari, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
