SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, by Decision Number 9863, dated December 12, 1921, as amended, authorized Fresno City Water Corporation to issue and sell \$400,000 of its "Series A of 1956" first and refunding six and a half percent. bonds subject to the condition, among others, that the proceeds from the sale of \$48,942.53 of said bonds be expended only for such purposes as the Railroad Commission might thereafter authorize, and

WHEREAS, Fresno City Water Corporation reports that subsequent to September 30, 1921 and prior to January 31, 1922 it expended \$56,010.85 for extensions, additions and betterments to its properties, and

WHEREAS, applicant asks permission to use the proceeds from the sale of the \$48,942.53 of bonds authorized by Decision Number 9863 to reimburse its treasury and to pay, in part, the cost of these expenditures, which are reported in detail in Exhibits "A", "B", "C" and "D" filed in the above entitled matters on March 2, 1922,

and,

The Railroad Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9863, dated December 12, 1921, as amended, be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit Fresno City Water Corporation to use the proceeds from the sale of the \$48,942.53 of bonds referred to in Condition "3" of the order in said decision, to finance, in part, the cost of the extensions, additions and betterments referred to herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9863, dated December 12, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
