## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER:

WHEREAS, the Reilroad Commission, by Decision Number 9872, dated December 16, 1921, authorized Ojai Power Company to issue and sell \$31,500.00 of its capital stock subject, among others, to the condition that approximately \$10,540.32 of the proceeds from the sale of such stock be deposited in a special bank account and expended only as authorized by the Railroad Commission in supplemental orders, and

WHEREAS, Ojai Power Company, in its supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter on March 1, 1922, asks permission to withdraw \$3,146.00 from the special bank account to finance the cost of extensions, additions and betterments which are described in some detail in the supplemental petition, and

The Railroad Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ojai Power Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to use not exceeding \$3,146.00 of the proceeds obtained, or to be obtained, from the sale of the stock authorized by the order in Decision Number 9872, dated December 16, 1921, to finance the cost of constructing and acquiring the extensions, additions and betterments described in the supplemental

petition filed in the above entitled matter on March 1, 1922.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9872 dated December 16, 1921, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
