ORDER

In this proceeding J. R. Langille has filed a joint ap-
plication with Leo Wurschmidt in which they petition the Rail-
road Commission for an order authorizing J. R. Langille to
lease to Leo Wurschmidt the operative right and equipment en-
gaged as a common carrier of passengers by automobile stage
between Chico, Butte County, California and Hamilton City,
Glenn County, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be leased was
obtained by applicant Langille under Decision No. 8647 in Ap-
plication No. 6551, dated February 21, 1921, which decision
authorized one Guy E. Heaton to sell and J. R. Langille to purchase
the operative right obtained by Guy E. Heaton due to operation
in good faith prior to May 1st, 1917, and continuously from that
date to date of transfer.

The lease agreement, a copy of which is attached to the
application herein and marked Exhibit "A" does not provide for any
monetary consideration, but requires that the lessee shall operate

such stage line in accordance with the law and the rules and regulations of the Railroad Commission during the pendency of such lease which is to run from the 28th day of January 1922 to the 28th day of January 1923. The lessee in consideration for the operation of such stage line is to receive all revenues therefrom.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicants herein shall immediately file a supplement to the tariff of rates and time schedules at present on file with this Commission covering the route herein proposed to be leased, such supplement to show that applicant Langille has cancelled and applicant Wurschmidt has adopted such tariff of rates and time schedules for the period covered by the lease herein authorized.
