O P I N I O N

In this proceeding P. Kawalowski and J. M. Goyke make joint application for authority to transfer the water service of consumers of P. Kawalowski, in Tract No. 3162, Los Angeles County, to J. M. Goyke.

A public hearing was held in the above entitled matter at Los Angeles before Examiner Williams, of which hearing all interested parties were notified and given an opportunity to appear and to be heard.

The testimony shows that J. M. Goyke owns and operates a public utility water system with pipe lines laid along the street immediately in front of the lots of the above named tract. Mr. Goyke has an ample supply of water and is in a position to give a more adequate water service than Mr. Kawalowski. In fact, Mr. Goyke has supplied water to this tract since a breakdown occurred in Mr. Kawaloski's pump, some two months ago.

Mr. Kawalowski has at the present time four consumers, all of whom, except Mrs. Esther A. Hamley, have signed a petition signifying their willingness to be transferred to the Goyke water system. Mrs. Hamley admitted the adequacy of the Goyke water system, but claimed certain contractual rights, which have no bearing on this proceeding.

The money consideration in this transfer amounted to approximately \$60.00, which covers the cost of the services installed at the present time.

It appears that Mr. Kawalowski wishes to withdraw from the public utility business, and that the transfer of the water service as indicated, would be in the public interest.

O R D E R

Application having been made to the Railroad Commission, as entitled above, wherein P. Kawalowski and J. M. Goyke join in an application for authority to transfer certain public utility water service from the former to the latter, a public hearing having been held thereon, and the matter having been submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

- 1- The property to be transferred consists of the service connections that now exist, and the public utility service of water to Tract No. 3162, Los Angeles County.
- 2- The authority herein granted shall apply only to such conveyance as shall have been made on or before June 1, 1922,
- 3- Within ten (10) days from the date of which P. Kawalowski actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized, said P. Kawalowski shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which such control was relinquished.

- 4- The consideration given for the transfer of said public utility water property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of the value of said properties for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
