Caruthers through the issue of the notes authorized by the order in said decision, as may be expended for properties not used or useful in their public utility business.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 10291, dated April 6, 1922, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
