ELEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, having reported that during the month of February, 1922, it expended for capital purposes the sum of \$48,745.61, as shown in Exhibit "A" attached to the Twelfth Supplemental Petition in the above entitled matter, and having asked permission to use \$48,745.61 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the first and refunding mortgage bonds, or interim certificates, which were authorized to be issued and sold by Decision Number 8731, dated March 10, 1921, as amended, to finance these expenditures;

AND the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The California Oregon Power Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to expend an additional \$48,745.61 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the first and refunding mortgage bonds, or interim certificates, which were authorized to be issued and sold by Decision Number 8731, dated -

March 10, 1921, as amended, to finance the capital expenditures reported in the Twelfth Supplemental Petition in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 8731, dated March 10, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Eleventh Supplemental Order.
