FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears that considerable expense to San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation will result if it be required to read all meters on agricultural service during the period from May 1st, to May 10th, 1922; and;

WHEREAS, it appears that no detriment will result to the agricultural consumers if meters on agricultural service are read throughout the month of May 1922, on the regular meter reading dates as heretofore in effect;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 10348 be modified to the effect that San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation be authorized to read meters on agricultural service throughout the month of May 1922 on the regular meter reading dates as heretofore in effect.
