BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS; this Commission in its Decision No. 9132 in the above entitled matter; dated June 22, 1921, authorized the Los Angeles Gas & Electric Corporation to charge and collect in addition to the schedule of rates therein set forth, the sum of 3 cents per thousand cubic feet for all gas sold based on meter readings taken on and after the first day of August, 1921, and until such time as it had collected thereunder the total sum of \$249,000.00 and not thereafter; and;

WHEREAS; it appears from investigation by this Commission that the Company will have received the total sum of \$249,000.00 as provided for in said Decision No. 9132; by the application of the 3 cent charge upon bills based on regular meter readings taken on and after August 1, 1921; and on and before May 1, 1922;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation discontinue the charge of 3 cents per thousand cubic feet based on regular meter readings taken on and after May 2, 1922.
