BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

BAY SIDE LAND COMPANY, a corporation, having asked permission to sell for \$8,466.84, to the City of Seal Beach, the public utility water properties described in the agreement filed in this proceeding, and the City of Seal Beach having joined in the application, and the Commission having considered applicants' request and being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions of this order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Bay Side Land Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to sell to the City of Seal Beach the properties described in the agreement filed in this proceeding, said sale to be made pursuant to the terms and conditions of said agreement and the conditions of this order; provided-

- 1...That the parties in interest will not claim that the consideration received for said properties determines the value of property similarly situated.

2.... That Bay Side Land Company will, within ten days after it relinquishes possession of the property, advise the Commission of the date on which the City of Seal Beach took possession of the property and of the date on which title to the property was transferred to the City of Seal Beach.
