NENTURA COUNTY RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, having on October 23. 1913, filed with the Commission an application for permission to lease to Southern Pacific Company trackage rights over applicant's "Y" track at Ownerd Station. Ventura County, California, and it appearing to the Commission that it is a public convenience for applicant and also Southern Pacific Company to use said "Y" track jointly for the purpose of turning engines and trains at Ownerd Station; and it further appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application which is filed under and pursuant to provisions of Section 51 of the Public Utilities Act should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.

THE REFERS ORDERED that permission be horeby granted Venture County Railway Company to lease to Southern Pacific Company trackage rights over the "Y" track of applicant at Oxmard Station. Venture County, California, as requested in the application and subject to the following conditions, viz:

(1) All engines, motors, trains and cars of both applicant and Southern Pacific Company shall be operated on said "Y" track and also on either side thereof for a distance not less than two thousand (2000) foot, under complete control.

- (2) Applicant and Southern Pacific Company shall execute an agreement for the use of said "Y" track by the engines, motors, trains and cars of said Southern Pacific Company, in which said Southern Pacific Company agrees to pay applicant a reasonable sum for the use of said "Y" track.
- (3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the operation and maintenance of said "Y" track as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
