By the Commission,

VENTURA COUNTY RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation,
having on October 23, 1913, filed with the Commission an appli-
cation for permission to lease to Southern Pacific Company track-
age rights over applicant's "Y" track at Oxnard Station, Ventura
County, California, and it appearing to the Commission that it
is a public convenience for applicant and also Southern Pacific
Company to use said "Y" track jointly for the purpose of turning
engines and trains at Oxnard Station; and it further appearing
to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hear-
ing is necessary, and that the application which is filed under and
pursuant to provisions of Section 51 of the Public Utilities Act
should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted
Ventura County Railway Company to lease to Southern Pacific Company
trackage rights over the "Y" track of applicant at Oxnard Station,
Ventura County, California, as requested in the application and sub-
ject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) All engines, motors, trains and cars of both appli-
cant and Southern Pacific Company shall be operated on said "Y"
track and also on either side thereof for a distance not less than
two thousand (2000) feet, under complete control.

(2) Applicant and Southern Pacific Company shall execute an agreement for the use of said "Y" track by the engines, motors, trains and cars of said Southern Pacific Company, in which said Southern Pacific Company agrees to pay applicant a reasonable sum for the use of said "Y" track.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the operation and maintenance of said "Y" track as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
