In the matter of the application of Delta Telephone & Telegraph Company, a corporation, and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, for an order authorizing the Delta Telephone & Telegraph Company to sell to The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company its telephone property between a point at 21st and Y Streets and a point at New Freeport Boulevard and Sutterville Road, Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company to purchase and acquire the same.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Delta Telephone & Telegraph Company and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the former to sell and transfer, and the latter to purchase and acquire certain telephone property situate between a point at 21st and Y Streets and a point at New Freeport Boulevard and Sutterville Road, Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, for the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) and applicants having set forth in said application as the reasons for desiring to transfer said property, as follows:

That the present lead of the Delta Company, between the points referred to, is carrying circuits of the Delta Company and of The Pacific Company, the majority of the circuits thereon being the property of The Pacific Company; that this condition results in a divided responsibility for maintenance; that both companies desire to correct these conditions, and that The Pacific Company is willing to assume the entire responsibility of the plant between the points referred to.

And a copy of the proposed instrument of transfer to be executed and delivered by the Delta Company to The Pacific Company being attached to said application, describing the property which it is proposed to transfer, as follows:

10 35' Round Cedar Poles  
14 30' " " "  
24 6-Pin Cross Arms  
5.16 Loop Miles of Iron Wire

and, it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the application herein be and the same hereby is granted, provided that the consideration given for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall not be taken before this Commission or any other public body as representing, for rate fixing or other purposes, the value of the property transferred, and provided further that the authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as is made on or before July 31, 1922.
