


In this proceeding Tony F. Tenent has made application to the Railroad Commission in which he petitions for a certificate authorizing the establishment of an automobile stage line for the transportation of passengers between Burlingame and Pacific City, San Mateo County, California.

A hearing was set on the above entitled proceeding before Examiner Satterwhite on June 2nd, 1922, at San Francisco. Upon the calling of such proceeding, applicant failed to appear, and through his attorney stated that he desired to withdraw his petition. In view of the fact that applicant herein has filed a formal application with this Commission for a certificate, has permitted such application to be set for hearing, and the hearing called without previously notifying the Commission that he has changed his intention and does not desire to proceed with the same, we are of the opinion that the present application should be denied, and that furthermore, applicant herein in

connection with any other application which he might hereafter file with this Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers or property for compensation, must first be required to make a satisfactory showing before the Commission that he desires to proceed with the service proposed in such application before the same will be set for hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is denied.
