FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The Railroad Commission by Decision No. 10391, dated May 2, 1922, established a schedule of rates to be charged by N. M. Peterson for water service to his consumers in Fetter's Springs, Sonoma County. This schedule of rates, among other things, provided as follows:

"7. For the irrigation of lawns or gardens, for each 100 square feet \$.10".

It appearing that the above amount of ten cents is a typographical error,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the schedule of rates established by the Commission in Decision Number 10391, dated May 2, 1922, be, and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"7. For the irrigation of lawns, or gardens,
for each 100 square feet \$.02 "

Except as amended above the rates established in said decision No.10391 shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that N. M. Peterson be and he is hereby directed to file with the Railroad Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this order the amendment as ordered above, said amendment to become effective immediately upon receipt by this Commission.
