O R D E R

In this proceeding California Transit Company, a corporation, has filed with the Railroad Commission a petition in which it asks for an Order authorizing it to lease to one E. M. Huston a certain operative right authorizing the operation of an automobile passenger stage line between Stockton, San Joaquin County, California, and Byron, Contra Costa County, California, and intermediate points. The operative right herein proposed to be leased was obtained by the California Transit Company under Decision No. 10183 in Application No. 6811, dated March 11, 1922, which decision authorized one C. D. Gallick to sell and the California Transit Company to purchase the operative right herein proposed to be leased. The lease agreement, copy of which is attached to the application herein, provides that this operative right is to be leased to applicant, Huston, for a period of one year at an annual rental of \$100.00 per month, this rental to include the services of the California Transit Company's stage depot at Stockton, together with the services of ticket sellers on duty at said stage depot.

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted;




IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same is, hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant California Transit Company, a corporation, shall cancel, for the period of the lease herein authorized, its tariff of rates and time schedules covering passenger stage service between Stockton, Byron and intermediate points; and E. M. Huston shall file, in his own name, tariff of rates and time schedules identical with the tariff of rates and time schedules temporarily cancelled by applicant California Transit Company, such filing to expressly state that it is effective only for the period of the lease herein authorized.

2. That the operative right herein authorized to be leased shall not be transferred, abandoned re-leased or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer, abandonment, re-lease or assignment has first been secured.

3. That no cars shall be operated under the certificate herein authorized to be leased unless such cars are owned by the lessee or leased by him under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
