O R D E R

A public hearing having been held in the above entitled application, the matter being submitted and now ready for decision,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Vern Heliot of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Fresno and Sharpville, Grabner, Prather, and ~~W. P. ...~~ ^{old Auberry}, but that public convenience and necessity do not require the operation of such service between Fresno and Auberry, and

IT IS ORDERED that certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant shall file within a period of ten (10) days from date hereof his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted, such written acceptance to contain a statement to the effect that his operations will be confined to the territory as covered by the certificate herein, and shall file within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof, in duplicate, tariffs of rates and time schedules identical with the tariffs of rates and time schedules contained in his application herein, and shall commence operating within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof.

2. The operative right herein granted shall not be transferred, abandoned, leased or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer, abandonment, lease or assignment has first been secured.

3. No vehicle shall be operated by Vern Heliot under the certificate herein granted unless such vehicle is owned by applicant or is leased by him under an agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
