O R D E R

Crescent Investment Company, a corporation, and H. R. Gibson and S. G. Downs, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Bay View Water Company, having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer to East Bay Water Company their water system supplying certain portions of the City of Oakland, and East Bay Water Company having joined in the application,

And it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Crescent Investment Company, a corporation, and H. R. Gibson and S. G. Downs, co-partners doing business under the name and style of Bay View Water Company, are hereby authorized to transfer to East Bay Water Company their water system supplying certain portions of the City of

Oakland, as described in the application herein, subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before October 1, 1922, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Crescent Investment Company and H. R. Gibson and S. G. Downs within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Crescent Investment Company and H. R. Gibson and S. G. Downs actually relinquish control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, said parties shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this water system shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
