SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the proceeds from the bonds heretofore authorized to be issued in the above entitled proceeding, said proceeds not to exceed the sum of \$2,718.00, may be utilized for the purpose of ballasting the applicant's line of railroad over 33 blocks in the city of Stockton, as provided in supplemental order this day entered in Application No. 336, and also that applicant may pledge bonds authorized to be issued in the above entitled application as security for the payment of moneys borrowed for said purpose in an amount not to exceed \$2,718.00, not to exceed \$2.00 of bonds to be pledged as security for \$1.00 of indebtedness.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the time within which the bonds authorized to be issued in the above entitled application may be issued is hereby extended to and including April 1, 1914.
