FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS a public hearing was held before Examiner Satterwhite in the City of Chico on the 22d day of June, 1922, in the matter of the application of the C. C. White Water Company, also known as the White Brothers Water Company, for an increase in water rates, being Application No. 7810 and which is now pending before the Commission, and

WHEREAS the evidence submitted at the hearing in the above matter indicates that there no longer exists any good and sufficient reason for further delay in compliance with the terms of the Commission's order in Decision No. 9726, wherein the White Brothers Water Company was directed to install certain improvements for the correction of the inadequate service and insufficient pressure existing on this water system,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's order of May 5, 1922, suspending the effective date of Decision No. 9726, dated November 8, 1921, be and it is hereby terminated, and except as the time limit for the installation of said improvements is extended as ordered below, said Decision No. 9726 shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that White Brothers Water Company be and it is hereby directed to install the improvements to its water system as ordered in said Decision No. 9726 as soon as conditions will permit, but in no case later than August 31, 1922.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that White Brothers Water Company be and it is hereby directed to submit to this Commission for its approval within twenty (20) days from the date of this order detailed plans outlining the proposed improvements as ordered in Decision No. 9726.
