IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use not exceeding \$251,502.10 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds authorized by Decision No. 10009, dated January 21, 1922, as amended, to finance its expenditures for capital purposes made during May, 1922, and reported in "Exhibit A" attached to the second supplemental petition in this decision.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 10009, dated January 21, 1922, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
