SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 10126 in the above entitled application, the Commission, on February 27th, 1922, issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing R. E. Williams, C. M. Bundy, and W. R. Smith, co-partners, doing business under the fictitious name of Graham Transportation Company, to operate an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Graham, an unincorporated community, and Los Angeles. It now appears from written statement of applicants herein that they are unable to render service due to the fact that on two different occasions their equipment has been taken from them, due to their inability to meet time payments thereon, and that at the present time they are financially unable to secure any equipment to operate the service authorized under Decision No. 10126. We are accordingly of the opinion that said Decision should be revoked and the certificate issued thereunder, annulled.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 10126 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
