BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9844 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to the rates therein established that such rates, upon approval of the Railroad Commission would be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of 3¢ per 1000 cubic feet for each 10¢ increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below the price of \$1.76 per barrel, f.o.b. Visalia, and

WHEREAS, Central Counties Gas Company has heretofore filed affidavit that the price paid for oil was reduced 41¢ per barrel and the Commission has, in consequence, in Decision No. 10779 ordered reduction of 12¢ per 1000 cubic feet, effective August 15, 1922, and

WHEREAS, Central Counties Gas Company now makes affidavit that effective July 27, 1922, a further reduction of 25¢ per barrel is made in the price paid for oil, making a total reduction of 66¢ per barrel,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the rates set forth in Decision No. 9844, in Case No. 1661, designated as Schedules

A and B, be and they are hereby reduced by 20¢ per 1000 cubic feet. effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after August 27, 1922, this being a further reduction of 8¢ per 1000 cubic feet.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Central Counties Gas Company file with the Commission on or before August 27, 1922, a revision of its schedules to comply with this order.
