ORDER

Upon the reading and filing of the application of the California and Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, a corporation, for the approval by this Commission, pursuant to the provisions of section 2906 of the Political Code of the State of California, of the sale and award by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, State of California, of a wharf franchise to said applicant; and it appearing therefrom to the satisfaction of this Commission that it is in the public interest that said applicant should exercise the rights and privileges conferred by said franchise, and this Commission being of the further opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not required,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the approval of the Railroad Commission of the State of California be, and the same is hereby given for the sale and award by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, State of California, to the Calif-

ornia and Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, a corporation,
on the 17th day of July, 1922, Ordinance No. 166, of a certain
wharf franchise for the construction and maintenance of a wharf
on the southerly shore of the Straits of Carquinez, for a period
of twenty (20) years from and after the date of the passage and
taking effect of said ordinance.
