FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9133 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to Rate Schedules Nos. A-1, A-4 and A-5 therein established that such rates, upon approval of the Railroad Commission, would be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of 1 cent per 1000 cubic feet for each 10 cent increase or decrease respectively in the cost of oil as might from time to time be authorized on the system of the Los Angeles Gas & Electric Corporation, and

WHEREAS, this Commission has this day by Decision No. 10887 ordered Los Angeles Gas & Electric Corporation to reduce its gas rates as specified in Decision No. 9132, by 7 cents per 1000 cubic feet, this being a further reduction of 2 cents per 1000 cubic feet,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the rates as set forth in Decision No. 9133 in Application No. 6338, designated as Schedules Nos. A-1, A-4 and A-5, be and they are hereby reduced by 7 cents per 1000 cubic feet, effective for all regular meter

readings taken on and after October 1, 1922, this being a further reduction of 2 cents per 1000 cubic feet.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Southern California Gas Company file with the Commission on or before October 1, 1922, a revision of its schedules to comply with this Order.
