O P I N I O N

The Railroad Commission having by its Order dated the Twenty-fourth day of September, 1920, Decision No. 8146, in Application No. 5767, in the matter of the application of various telephone companies for an order modifying General Order No. 57, authorized all telephone utilities, operating within the State of California and furnishing the classes of telephone service as to which the charges therein provided for are designed to become applicable, to file with the Commission, within thirty (30) days of the date of said order, a revised rule establishing and making effective on and after August 1st, 1920 a schedule of charges as therein set forth and, Consolidated Utilities Company having failed to file its revised rule establishing and making effective a schedule of charges as set forth and as modified, within the time therein provided for, and the said Consolidated Utilities Company having on August 8th, 1922, filed with the Railroad Commission its application for authority to establish and make effective said charges and, it appearing to the Railroad Commission that this is

not a matter requiring a public hearing,

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Consolidated Utilities Company be and is hereby authorized to file with the Railroad Commission, within thirty (30) days of the date of the Order herein, a revised rule establishing and making effective on and after September 1st, 1922 a schedule of charges as set forth in said Decision No. 8146, dated the Twenty-fourth day of September, 1920.
