THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9839 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to the rates therein established that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease upon the basis of 2.6 cents per 1000 cubic feet for each 10 cent increase or decrease, respectively, in the cost of oil above or below the price of \$2.00 per barrel, upon approval of the Railroad Commission, and

WHEREAS, Modesto Gas Company has heretofore filed with this Commission affidavit that the price paid for oil has been reduced by 43 cents per barrel, and the Commission having in consequence in Decision No. 10735 ordered reductions totaling 11 cents per 1000 cubic feet; and

WHEREAS, Modesto Gas Company now makes affidavit that the price paid for oil has been reduced to \$1.32 per barrel, this being a further decrease of 25 cents and a total decrease of 68 cents per barrel from the price on which rates were established in Decision No. 9839,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the rates set forth in Decision No. 9839 in Case No. 1662, designated as Schedules A and B, be, and they are hereby reduced by 17 cents per 1000 cubic feet effective for all regular meter readings taken on

and after September 8, 1922, this being a further reduction of 6 cents per 1000 cubic feet.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Modesto Gas Company file with the Commission on or before September 9, 1922, a revision of its schedules to comply with this order.
