ORDER

Chas. Preston and P. H. Peterson have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing Preston to lease to Peterson a certain automobile stage franchise authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage, express and freight between Korbel and Maple Creek, Humboldt County, California.

The lease agreement, copy of which is attached to the application herein, provides that applicant Peterson shall take over and operate the above named stage line for a period of four years at an annual rental of \$15.00 per year, terminating upon June 30th, 1926.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was originally obtained by applicant Preston under Decision No. 8131 in Application No. 6084, dated September 23, 1920.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant Peterson shall immediately file his adoption of the tariff of rates and time schedules at present on file with the Railroad Commission by applicant Preston, such adoption to expire at the termination of the lease herein authorized.

2. That the certificate herein authorized to be leased shall not be released by applicant Peterson without the written authorization of the Railroad Commission.
