THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

OJAI POWER COMPANY, in its Third Supplemental Petition filed in the above entitled matter on August 24, 1922, reports that it proposes to expend \$3,521.82 in the construction and acquisition of extensions, additions and betterments to its electric and water plants and systems. To finance the cost of these proposed expenditures, which are set forth in some detail in exhibits attached to the supplemental petition, applicant asks permission to use \$3,521.82 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the stock, the issue and sale of which the Commission authorized by Decision Number 9872, dated December 16, 1921.

The Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes that it should be granted, as herein provided.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ojai Power Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to use \$3,521.82 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the stock authorized by Decision Number 9872, dated December 16, 1921, as amended, to finance the expenditures described in the Third Supplemental Application filed in the above entitled matter.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9872, dated December 16, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
