O R D E R

Application in the above entitled proceeding having been filed with the Railroad Commission, asking for an order of the Commission authorizing the sale by Mrs. Mary A. Latour, owner of a small telephone exchange, located in Snelling, Merced County, California, to Mrs. Frank Hendricks for the sum of \$45.60, said exchange being described in said application as follows:

- 1 10 line switchboard
- 5 instruments with poles, wire, etc.
- 1 hand generator
- 1 coin box, etc.

and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter requiring a public hearing and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mrs. Mary A. Latour be and she is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Mrs. Frank Hendricks a telephone exchange located in Snelling, Merced County, California, as hereinabove described, for the sum of \$45.60, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mrs. Frank Hendricks be and she is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire the same; provided, that applicant shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order, file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of a bill of sale or other instrument by which the property herein described is authorized to be sold and transferred to Mrs. Frank Hendricks.
