## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph 1 of the order contained in Decision No. 11026 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"The transportation of freight between San Diego, Tecate and intermediate points shall be confined solely to packages of which no single shipment from one consignor to one consignee shall weigh in excess of 50 pounds, the total weight of such shipments in any one day not to exceed 250 pounds, with the exception of milk and cream of which commodity the total shipments in any one day shall not weigh in excess of 250 pounds. Passenger traffic is to be limited solely to through passengers destined to or originating at Tecate. No transportation of passengers locally between San Diego and Potrero and intermediate points is hereby authorized or permitted."
