The Moore Park Water, Light and Power Company, a public utility corporation serving water for domestic purposes in and in the vicinity of the Town of Moorpark, Ventura County, having through its president applied to this Commission for authority to sell its public utility property to Ventura County Water District No. 1, and the Supervisors of the County of Ventura, on behalf of Ventura County Water District No. 1, having joined in said application,

And it appearing that the interests of the water users on this system will be better served if such transfer is made, and it further appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,


O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Moore Park Water, Light and Power Company be and it is hereby authorized to sell and convey to said Ventura County Water District No. 1 its certain water distributing system, together with lands, etc., pertaining thereto, more particularly described in the form of deeds attached to and accompanying the application, known as "Exhibit "A" thereof,

subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before December 31, 1922, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed by Moore Park Water, Light and Power Company, with this Commission within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed,
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Moore Park Water, Light and Power Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished,
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this public utility property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
