
SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 10504 in the above entitled proceeding A. Nicolette was authorized to sell and D. S. McCarty to purchase and operate a certain automobile stage line together with a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing its operation between Santa Rosa and Monte Rio, California. Said Decision provided that the proposed purchaser should immediately file in his own name, tariff of rates and time schedules, or adopt the tariff of rates and time schedules heretofore filed by his predecessor in interest. Requirements of said Order were not complied with, nor has the Commission, through correspondence, been able to locate said D. S. McCarty, and upon information to the effect that said D. S. McCarty has not at any time operated under the certificate authorized to be transferred to him, we are of the opinion that Decision No. 10504 should be revoked and annulled.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 10504 in the above entitled proceeding be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and the certificate therein

authorized to be transferred to, and it hereby is cancelled.
